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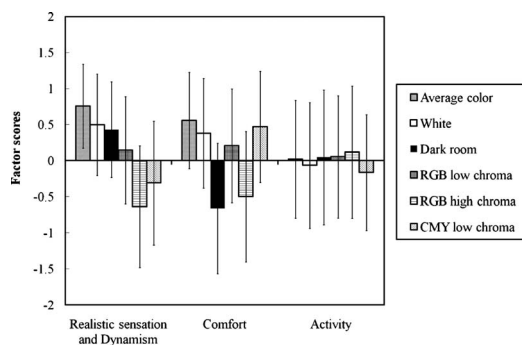


Figure 10. Figure 10. Factor scores of experiment 2. The error bars correspond to one standard deviation of the mean.

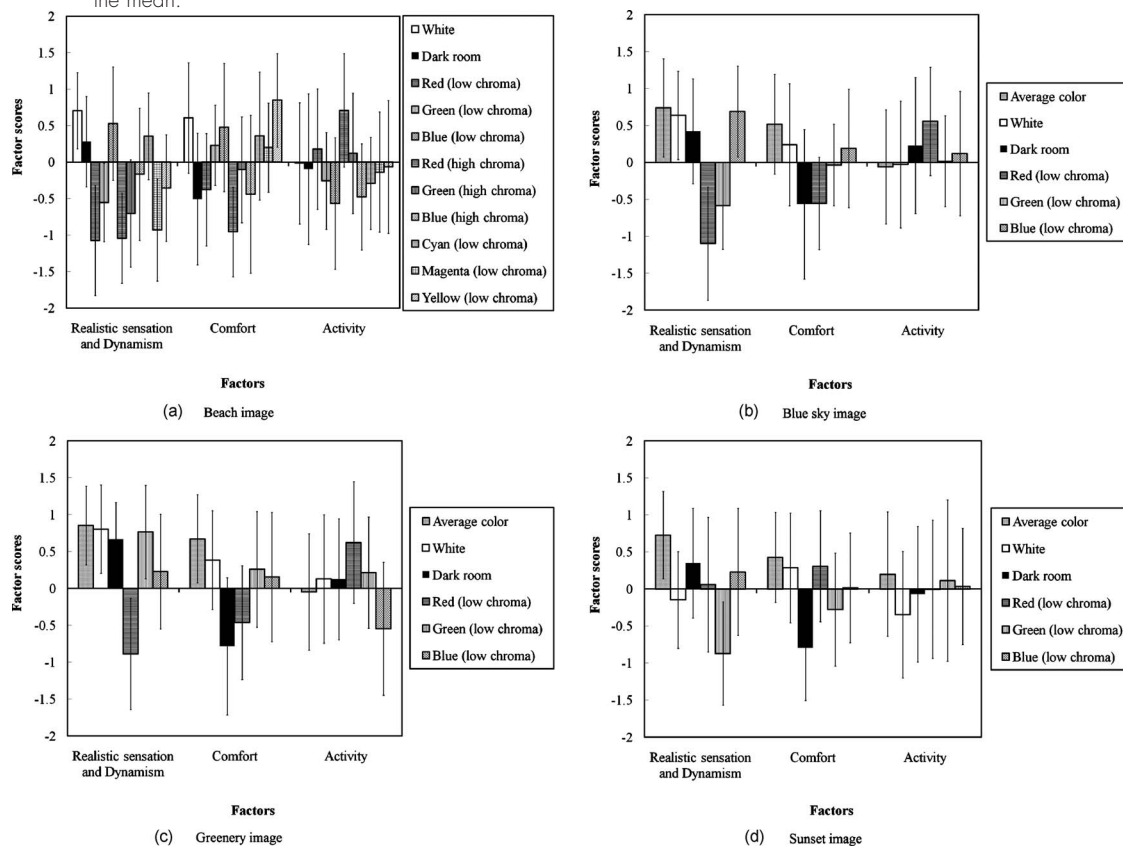


Figure 11. Figure 11. Factor scores of each image of experiment 2: (a) beach image, (b) blue sky image, (c) greenery image, and (d) sunset image. The error bars correspond to one standard deviation of the mean.

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
